Status Report regarding Mitigation of Unreinforced Masonry Buildings – *Item discussed (Balma, Martinek, Rosales – Absent)*

Neighborhood Services

CALHome First Time Homebuyer Program - In May of 2009, Neighborhood Services received a \$900,000 grant from the State of California Housing and Community Development (HCD) to fund the City of Oceanside CalHome First Time Homebuyer Program. The CalHome Program helps make homeownership a possibility for first-time homebuyers who meet specified low and moderate income limits and provides a deferred-payment junior loan in the maximum amount of \$56,000 per household. This junior loan is to be combined with a first mortgage loan provided by City-approved lenders.

Our CalHome grant was due to expire on September 9, 2014. On June 4, 2014 we requested an extension for expenditure of the remaining CalHome mortgage assistance funds from HCD. A portion of our grant funds are currently committed to eleven (11) households, nine (9) of which have attained homeownership, and two (2) out shopping for a home. With the improving economy and consumer confidence in owning a home, along with our best efforts at marketing using website exposure and community forums, we expect to expend the remaining funds within the next year.

On September 4, 2014, Neighborhood Services received approval for our request, along with an amended Agreement from HCD valid through September 9, 2015. Neighborhood Services takes great pride in the opportunity to provide assistance to low-income households in attaining homeownership. Now, with the extended deadline, we can confidently continue in our efforts to attract viable applicants and further affordable housing in Oceanside.

Mother with a Message Workshop - City of Oceanside, Neighborhood Services Department is partnering with Oceanside Police Department, Oceanside Unified School District and other community organizations in hosting a Gang Prevention/Intervention Workshop at Oceanside High School (Multi-Purpose Room), on Thursday, September 25 from 5:30-8:00 p.m. titled: *Mother's With A Message*. Workshop will include guest speakers from prevention and intervention groups on measures parents and residents can take to prevent and reduce youth

violence as well as an opportunity for those impacted by violence to start the healing process. Through collaboration efforts, residents of Oceanside will have an opportunity to hear the presenters as well as have access to community organizations and resources from Oceanside Police Department's Crime Prevention/Neighborhood Policing Team, Vista Community Clinic, NC Lifeline, OUSD school campus programs, faith-based groups, Drug & Alcohol Prevention and/or Treatment youth programs and other youth programs.
