LIFE OF LIBERTY – Consideration of a CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT (CUP14-00020) to allow the operation of a general day care facility within an existing commercial building at 1006 Mission Avenue (Mission Square Shopping Center). The proposed facility would be housed within a 16,875-square-foot suite most recently occupied by a charter school (The School of Business and Technology). ***Staff is recommending approval.***

COCA-COLA EXPANSION – Consideration of a DEVELOPMENT PLAN (D14-00001) and CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT (CUP14-00002) involving the expansion of an existing warehouse and distribution facility on a 25.1-acre property located at 3900 Ocean Ranch Boulevard. ***Staff is recommending approval.***
