

## **CITY COUNCIL WEEKLY UPDATE**

### **Planning Division**

### **Successor Agency**

The California Coastal Commission will consider the Successor Agency's proposed changes to the Redevelopment Area Zoning Ordinance at their June 12-14 meeting in Long Beach. The proposed zoning changes include changing certain retail and office uses from "Conditional Use Permit" to "Permitted" use, and permitting new drive through/drive-up facilities in the 6A sub-area. The 6A area is located at the far west end of the City limits south of North Coast Highway. Also proposed is to redesignate the zoning of the 900 block of North Coast Highway, currently occupied by Carrow's, the Chamber of Commerce, and the California Welcome Center, from 7B (Recreational, Commercial, Residential) to 6A (Visitor Serving Commercial). This zoning change, along with any suggested Coastal Commission modifications, would then come back to the Community Development Commission for adoption and/or further modification. This will likely occur at an August City Council meeting.
