Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission reviewed and took action on at their meeting on Monday, June 10, 2013:

MOHSEN'S @ 628 S. COAST HWY — Consideration of a Regular Coastal Permit (RC13-00002) and Conditional Use Permit (CUP13-00007) to permit the conversion of an existing 1,350-square-foot vehicle service bay into a food market in association with an existing gas station located at 628 South Coast Highway. *The Commission voted 5-0 (Balma, Rosales — Absent) to continue this item to the June 24, 2013 Planning Commission meeting.*

SPRINT @ 805 COLLEGE BLVD. — Consideration of a CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT (CUP12-00019), a request for approval to allow for equipment upgrades necessary to accommodate fourth generation wireless technologies and the continued operation of an existing wireless communication facility located at 805 College Boulevard. *The Commission denied the project without prejudice by a 4-1 vote (Neal — No; Balma, Rosales — Absent). The call for review/appeal period ends on June 20, 2013.*

SPRINT @ 551 SOUTH EL CAMINO REAL — Consideration of a CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT (CUP12-00026), a request for approval to allow equipment upgrades necessary to accommodate fourth generation wireless technologies and the continued operation of an existing wireless communication facility located at 551 South El Camino Real. *The Commission denied the project without prejudice by a 5-0 vote (Balma, Rosales — Absent). The call for review/appeal period ends on June 20, 2013.*

RAU ADDITION – Consideration of a REGULAR COASTAL PERMIT (RC13-00001) to allow a 714-square-foot second-story addition and major remodel of an existing single-story residence located at 1728 South Pacific Street. *The Commission approved the project by a 5-0 vote (Balma, Rosales – Absent) and adopted the resolution. The call for review/appeal period ends on June 20, 2013.*
