On Friday, October 25, from 9:00 a.m. -1:00 p.m. in the Community Rooms, there will be FEMA Public Meeting to discuss the results of their October 23, 2013, SONGS (San Onofre) biennial Plume Phase Exercise, organized by the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services. They expect a crowd and press; they have arranged for a CHP Representative to be there in uniform to handle crowds and/or demonstrators, if necessary.

Development Services

Mission Avenue Improvement Project – Starting Thursday, October 24, 2013, the two day process to convert Seagaze Drive to a one-way eastbound street will begin. The one-way conversion will take place in two phases.

On October 24, 2013, the westbound lane on Seagaze Drive will be closed for removal/replacement of the signing and roadway striping. The southbound lane on Clementine Street (between Mission and Seagaze) will be closed for removal/replacement of the signing and roadway striping.

On Friday, October 25, 2013, the eastbound lane on Seagaze Drive will be closed for removal/replacement of the signing and roadway striping. The northbound lane on Clementine Street (between Mission and Seagaze) will be closed for removal/replacement of the signing and roadway striping. When the work is complete on October 25, 2013, Seagaze Drive will open as a one-way street eastbound and this segment of Clementine Street will be one-way northbound.

Mission Avenue will remain a two-way street until the conversion to a one-way street now scheduled to take place on Tuesday, November 12, 2013. Mission Avenue will remain open to traffic throughout the construction phase. For further information, please visit:
