The amendments involve repealing Article 33 Signs, of the 1986 Zoning Ordinance, modifying Article 33 of the 1992 Zoning Ordinance and establishing the amended text as part of the implementing document of the Local Coastal Program. Parks & Recreation and the YMCA

Parks & Recreation and YMCA have developed a partnership to address and deliver recreational programs to at risk neighborhoods and senior population. The Y Team has recently teamed up alongside recreation professionals to bring sports, fine arts, and education-based programs to children in Crown Heights and Eastside.

Crown Heights Resource Center children are currently enrolled in dance classes taught by Y Instructors. They have an opportunity to experience different dance genres while getting fit. Over 40 Balderrama Afterschool Program children, ages 5-9, are training to run in the upcoming Carlsbad Tri-City Medical Center Marathon Kid's Mile Race at Legoland on January 21. The Y has provided a trainer, and our City recreation staff is out there training with the kids. A Y bus will provide transportation the day of event, pay for the kid's race entrance, and then top off the day with free entrance to Legoland.

AgriService

The El Corazon Green Waste Facility continues to be a great neighbor to El Corazon Senior Center. Mary Mateva of AgriService donated over 40 poinsettias to beautify the Center for the holidays. The Senior Center hosted many senior social events and the plants added a special touch. All plants were sent home after the events as a special gift to Oceanside seniors.
