### PLANNING DIVISION

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission reviewed and took action on at their meeting on Monday, June 25, 2012:

<u>VERIZON @ LUISENO PARK</u> – Consideration of CONDITIONAL USE PERMITS (CUP11-00016 & CUP12-00005) to allow construction and operation of a wireless telecommunications facility, consisting of the replacement of an existing 69'-0" tall athletic field light standard with a new custom 69'-0" tall athletic field light standard that is designed with a 36" Radome toward the top of the light standard for the purpose of concealing a total of 12 panel antennas located within Luiseno Park. *The Commission approved the project by a 7-0 vote and adopted the resolution. The call for review/appeal period ends on July 5, 2012.* 

<u>AMERICAN TOWER CORP.</u> @ 4039 AVENIDA DE LA PLATA – Consideration of CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT (CUP10-00010) to allow the continued operation of the existing telecommunication facility concealed entirely within an existing 75-foot tall faux mono-pine cellular tower with associated ground equipment located at 4039 Avenida de la Plata. *The Commission approved the project by a 5-2 (Martinek, Ross – No) vote and adopted the resolution. The call for review/appeal period ends on July 5, 2012.* 

<u>OUANTUM LEARNING</u> – Consideration of CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT (CUP12-00003) to allow special occasions to occur, such as staff training for businesses, national and international educational meetings, weddings, quinceanera, conferences, annual events for businesses, various non-profit fund raiser events, seminars, receptions, and other activities held within an existing industrial office building located at 1938 Avenida Del Oro. *The Commission approved the project by a 7-0 vote and adopted the resolution. The call for review/appeal period ends on July 5, 2012.*
