

COUNCIL WEEKLY UPDATE

July 12, 2012

PLANNING DIVISION

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission reviewed and took action on at their meeting on Monday, July 9, 2012:

BRUSSO RESIDENCE ADDITION – Consideration of REGULAR COASTAL PERMIT (RC12-00006) to allow the demolition of an existing secondary dwelling unit on the eastern portion of the site and renovation of the single-family residence on the western portion of the site. The single-family residence is located at 1920 S. Pacific Street and is situated within the South Oceanside Neighborhood Planning Area and Coastal Zone. ***The Commission approved the project by a 5-0 vote (Rosales, Ross – Absent) and adopted the resolution. The call for review/appeal period ends on July 19, 2012.***

CHASE DRIVE-THRU ATM – Consideration of DEVELOPMENT PLAN (D12-00005), CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT (CUP12-00004), and HISTORIC PERMIT (H12-00001) to allow for the development of a freestanding drive-thru ATM within the existing parking lot of Old Grove Market Place located at 155 Old Grove Road within the Mission San Luis Rey Neighborhood. ***The Commission approved the project by a 5-0 vote (Rosales, Ross – Absent) and adopted the resolution. The call for review/appeal period ends on July 19, 2012.***

FLEET MANAGEMENT DIVISION

The City of Oceanside Fleet Management Division has once again made the list of “100 Best Fleets in North America” for the 2012 Government Fleet magazine. The 100 Best Fleets Awards Program recognizes leading fleets from across the country. The awards were announced at a Government Fleet Expo held in Denver, Colorado on June 20. There are over 38,000 public sector fleets in North America that are eligible for the award. In 2012, over 10,000 applications were distributed to fleets identified as performing high-quality work in the industry.

The City of Oceanside has a centralized fleet department responsible for purchasing, maintaining, servicing and disposing of the majority of City vehicles. Fleet Services, led by Fleet Supervisor Jeffery Hart, maintains over 470 vehicles and equipment including utility trucks, police cars, fire apparatus and ambulances.

This is the sixth time in eight years that The Fleet Management Division has been recognized as one of the 100 Best Fleets in North America. This award highlights Fleet Management’s continuing commitment to provide quality and competitive maintenance services to our customers in a timely and efficient manner, through collaboration of individual strengths, environmentally friendly options, and common goals, while always striving to improve.
