PLANNING DIVISION

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission reviewed and took action on at their meeting on Monday, September 24, 2012:

STONE VAIL REMODEL. Consideration of a REGULAR COASTAL PERMIT (RC12-00012) for the construction of an approximate 1,025 square feet of new floor area to an existing 3,230-square-foot home located at 30 Saint Malo Beach. The Commission approved the project by a 7-0 vote and adopted the resolution. The call for review/appeal period ends on October 4, 2012.

SFD @ 26 ST. MALO BEACH. Consideration of a REGULAR COASTAL PERMIT (RC12-00004) to permit the demolition of an existing 2,998-square-foot residence to allow the construction of a new 4,813-square-foot home with a three-car garage. The subject property is located at 26 Saint Malo Beach. *The Commission approved the project by a 7-0 vote and adopted the resolution. The call for review/appeal period ends on October 4, 2012.*

OLD MISSION SAN LUIS REY. Consideration of a DEVELOPMENT PLAN (D12-00009), CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT (CUP10-00010), and HISTORIC PERMIT (H12-00002) to allow the development of two freestanding mausoleum buildings within the existing Mission San Luis Rey Old Cemetery located at 4050 Mission Avenue. *The Commission approved the project by a 6-1 vote (Scrivener – No) and adopted the resolution. The call for review/appeal period ends on October 4, 2012.*

NEIGHBORHOOD SERVICES

OCSP GRANT APPLICATIONS. We received official notice that The City of Oceanside was unsuccessful in our OJJDP Community-Based Violence Prevention Program 2012 grant application submitted in May which sought funds for suppression, prevention, and intervention activities in the Eastside and Crown Heights neighborhoods for three years. We knew this would be a very competitive grant and four grants were awarded from sixty-four applications. The grants went to Los Angeles, Detroit, Philadelphia and Baton Rouge.

We are submitting a grant application through OCSP/OPD for the current CalGRIP RFP to fund youth programs and OPD-Directed Patrol activities in Eastside and Crown Heights from 1/1/2013 through 12/31/2014. That application is critical, as the current CalGRIP grant funding youth programs and OPD activities in these two neighborhoods ends 12/31/12.

Our CalGRIP grant for the Libby Lake/Back Gate area which was effective 7/1/2012 runs through 12/31/2013 and funds the REACH Program at Libby Lake Community Center for one year and OPD-Directed Patrol activities in the area for 18 months.
