Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission will review at their meeting on Monday, October 8, 2012:

ROADWAY AUTO TOWING – Consideration of a CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT (CUP12-00009) to establish a temporary auto tow yard on a portion of an existing developed site that is approximately 270,019 square feet in size and developed with a 29,225-square-foot single-story industrial building located at 1833 Oceanside Boulevard. The proposed auto tow yard would lease 24,436 square feet of the existing paved parking lot area for vehicle storage purposes and 754 square feet of the industrial building for office and vehicle retrieval purposes. (Item continued from the August 27, 2012 Planning Commission public hearing) *Staff is recommending approval.*

KATES RESIDENCE – Consideration of a REGULAR COASTAL PERMIT (RC11-00012) to demolish an existing single-family residence and construct a new 2,355-square-foot single-family residence with a 471-square-foot garage on an 11,768-square-foot vacant lot located at 1909 South Pacific Street. (Item continued from the September 10, 2012 Planning Commission public hearing) *Staff is recommending approval.*

BROWN RESIDENCE REMODEL – Consideration of a REGULAR COASTAL PERMIT (RC12-00014) to remodel and convert an existing single-story duplex into a two-story single-family residence on an approximately 6,040-square-foot lot located at 1910-1912 South Pacific Street and reduce existing legal non-conforming site coverage from 51 percent to 46 percent. *Staff is recommending approval.*

BURGESS/JOURNIGAN RESIDENCES – Consideration of a REGULAR COASTAL PERMIT (RC11-00002) to demolish two existing structures containing three residential units and construct a new three-story 6,424-square-foot structure containing two residential units at 1513 South Pacific Street. *Item has been continued to the October 22, 2012 Planning Commission public hearing.*
