Planning Commission

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission will review at their meeting on Monday, January 24, 2011.

RANCHO DEL ORO GATEWAY SHOPPING CENTER – Consideration of a Development Plan (D10-00009) for a text amendment to the Planned Block Development (PBD) Plan established for the 103,000-square-foot commercial retail center within an existing shopping center located on the southeast corner of College and Oceanside Boulevards. ***Staff is recommending approval.***

MELROSE EXTENSION – Certification of the Final Environmental Impact Report (FEIR) and select the preferred Alternative A (middle alignment) for Melrose Drive Extension project. ***Staff is recommending approval.***

SNAP (Spay and Neutering Service Program), a private nonprofit organization came out to Joe Balderrama Recreation Center this past weekend. SNAP spayed 42 pit bulls on Saturday, January 15, and spayed 80+ animals on Sunday, January 16. This was a \$200 value and offered to neighborhood residents for \$20 per pet. More than 50 percent of the animals received their shots and licenses.
