

COUNCIL WEEKLY UPDATE

January 27, 2011

Planning Commission

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission reviewed and took action on at their meeting on Monday, January 24, 2011:

RANCHO DEL ORO GATEWAY SHOPPING CENTER – Consideration of a Development Plan (D10-00009) for a text amendment to the Planned Block Development (PBD) Plan established for the 103,000-square foot commercial retail center within an existing shopping center located on the south east corner of College and Oceanside Boulevards. ***This item has been continued to the February 28, 2011, public hearing.***

MELROSE EXTENSION – Certification of the Final Environmental Impact Report (FEIR) and select the preferred Alternative A (middle alignment) for Melrose Drive Extension project. ***The Commission denied certification of the FEIR by a 6-0 vote (Scrivener – Absent) and the call for review/appeal period ends on February 3, 2011.***

TRAFFIC CALMING PROGRAM – ***The commission discussed the project and voted 6-0 (Scrivener – Absent) recommending approval to the City Council.***

OPARC Inaugural Board Elected

On January 25, 2011, the Oceanside Parks & Recreation Community Foundation Board was elected. This Board will act as a fundraising arm for Parks & Recreation Division. This group's goal will be to raise money for Concerts In The Parks, Movies In the Parks, Youth Scholarships and more.

Civic Center Library renovation progress

The Civic Center Library renovation is progressing very well. The new stairway has been constructed and carpeting has been installed on the second floor. The front entrance is currently boarded up for replacement of the sliding glass door. At this time construction is due to be completed on February 28. The Civic Center Library reopening is now scheduled for Wednesday, March 2, with a ribbon-cutting ceremony at 10 a.m. A volunteer recognition luncheon will be held on Friday, February 25, in the Community Rooms, and library volunteers will be able to preview the newly remodeled facility. Dedication of the Esther McCord memorial coffee corner will take place at that time. Councilmembers will receive invitations to both events.
