# **Planning Department**

For the City of Oceanside this includes funds received through the Community Development Block Grant - Recovery Act (CDBG-R) Program, the Homelessness Prevention and Rapid Rehousing Program (HPRP), and the Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant (EECBG) Program. The City has submitted reports covering the fourth quarter of calendar 2010; copies of these reports are available to the public on the City Web site under "Recovery Act Programs in Oceanside."
