Planning Department

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission will review at their meeting on Monday, March 28, 2011:

OCEAN RANCH BUSINESS ASSOCIATION – Consideration of a GENERAL PLAN AMENDMENT (GPA10-00003), ZONE AMENDMENT (ZA10-00003) a request to change the land use designation of a 36-acre parcel from Light Industrial (LI) to Open Space (OS) and change the zoning designation from Limited Industrial (IL) to Open Space (OS). The subject parcel currently exists as an undeveloped parcel overlaid with an open space easement, and the change in land use would provide for additional permanent Open Space within Oceanside. The project site is located south of Mesa Drive, and north of Ocean Ranch Boulevard within the Ivey Ranch/Rancho Del Oro Neighborhood – (Item continued from the March 14, 2011 Planning Commission agenda) Staff is recommending approval.

<u>JUNKYARD GRILL</u> – Consideration of a CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT (CUP11-00004) to permit full alcohol beverage service within a proposed restaurant known as Junkyard Grill within an existing commercial center located at 3613 Ocean Ranch Boulevard. *Staff is recommending approval.*

Open House for New Financial Opportunity Center

North County Life is hosting an open house and kick-off event for the new Financial Opportunity Center in the Americanization School / Crown Heights Resource Center on Saturday, March 26th from 10:00 am to 3:00 pm, and the public is most cordially invited to attend.
