Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission reviewed and took action on at their meeting on Monday, March 28, 2011.

OCEAN RANCH BUSINESS ASSOCIATION – Consideration of a GENERAL PLAN AMENDMENT (GPA10-00003), ZONE AMENDMENT (ZA10-00003) a request to change the land use designation of a 36-acre parcel from Light Industrial (LI) to Open Space (OS) and change the zoning designation from Limited Industrial (IL) to Open Space (OS). The project site is located south of Mesa Drive, and north of Ocean Ranch Boulevard within the Ivey Ranch/Rancho Del Oro Neighborhood – ***The Commission approved the project by a 6-0 vote (Scrivener – Absent) and adopted the resolution and the call for review/appeal period ends on April 7, 2011.***

JUNKYARD GRILL – Consideration of a CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT (CUP11-00004) to permit full alcohol beverage service within a proposed restaurant known as Junkyard Grill within an existing commercial center located at 3613 Ocean Ranch Boulevard. – ***The Commission approved the project by a 6-0 vote (Scrivener – Absent) and adopted the resolution and the call for review/appeal period ends on April 7, 2011.***

Family Self-Sufficiency Coordinator Funding Award

The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development has notified the City of an award of \$137,360 to pay the salaries of two Family Self-Sufficiency (FSS) Coordinators in the Neighborhood Services Department for Calendar Year 2011. The FSS Program has been available to households participating in the City's Housing Choice Voucher (Section 8) Program since 1993. Families in the program execute a contract that specifies goals and services; the contract requires that all members become independent of welfare and maintain suitable employment. The FSS Coordinators ensure that the program participants are linked to the supportive services they need to achieve self-sufficiency.
