Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission will review at their meeting on Monday, April 11, 2011:

<u>BEACHWALK LLC AND LEEDS LLC</u> – Consideration of a REGULAR COASTAL PERMITS (RC10-00002, RC10-00010) for the conversion of an existing six-unit multi-family complex into two single-family detached residences on separate legal lots, respectively located at 817 and 819 South Pacific Street. *This project has been continued and will be re-noticed for the April 25, 2011 public hearing.*

<u>T-MOBILE AT MELLANO FARMS</u> – Consideration of a CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT (CUP10-00002) to allow construction of a wireless telecommunication facility comprised of six panel antennas mounted upon a 47.5-foot monopalm tower on a 14.84-acre site accommodating agricultural operations and workforce housing at 851 Wilshire Road. *Staff is recommending approval.*

<u>SAMOAN CONGREGATIONAL CHRISTIAN CHURCH</u> – Consideration of a CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT (CUP10-00039) to permit a religious facility within an existing office building located at 141 Canyon Drive. *Staff is recommending approval.*

<u>CITY OF OCEANSIDE</u> – Introduction of an Ordinance for ZONE AMENDMENT (ZA11-00001) amending Articles 41 and 43 of the Oceanside Zoning Ordinance. – Second 24month automatic Time Extensions for Development Plans, Conditional Use Permits, Variances, and Regular Coastal Permits and first 24-month automatic Time Extension for Tentative Maps. *Staff is recommending approval.*

CDBG Action Plan

The draft 2011-2012 Action Plan is now available for public review and comment. This Action Plan sets forth how the City plans to use Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), HOME Investment Partnership and other federal, state and local funds for housing and community development in the program year that begins July 1, 2011. Following a thirty-day public comment period, the City will present the Action Plan to the City Council at a public hearing on May 4, 2011. Since Congress has not as yet appropriated funds for the current federal fiscal year, the City does not know its actual allocation; all CDBG income and expenditures shown for 2011-2012 are only estimates and have not been approved by the City Council. The draft Action Plan is available in print form at the Oceanside Public Library, the City Clerk's office and the offices of the Neighborhood Services Department, and in electronic form on the City Web site on the Housing page.
