COUNCIL WEEKLY UPDATE

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission reviewed and took action on at their meeting on Monday, April 25, 2011:

BEACHWALK LLC AND LEEDS LLC – Consideration of REGULAR COASTAL PERMITS (RC10-00002, RC10-00010) and VARIANCES (V11-00001, V11-00002) for the conversion of an existing six-unit multifamily complex into two single-family detached residences on separate legal lots, respectively located at 817 and 819 South Pacific Street. *The Commission denied the project without prejudice by a 3-2 vote* (Balma, Bertheaud – Absent) and the call for review/appeal period ends on May 5, 2011.

Introduction of an Ordinance for ZONE AMENDMENT (ZA11-00001) amending Articles 41 and 43 of the Oceanside Zoning Ordinance. – Second 24-month automatic Time Extensions for Development Plans, Conditional Use Permits, Variances, and Regular Coastal Permits and first 24-month automatic Time Extension for Tentative Maps. *This item was removed from the agenda and will be re-scheduled for a future public hearing.*

THE LLOYD WELLS GIFT TRUST – Consideration of a Tentative Parcel Map (P10-00002) for a two-lot industrial subdivision on a 17.058-acre parcel situated at 4010 Ocean Ranch Boulevard within the Ivey Ranch Rancho Del Oro Neighborhood. No development is associated with the parcel map and the subdivision is for financial purposes. *The Commission approved the project by a 5-0 vote (Balma, Bertheaud – Absent) and adopted the resolution and the call for review/appeal period ends on May 5, 2011.*

Administrative Approval: HOME DEPOT TEMPORARY NURSERY @ 2205 VISTA WAY (Southeast corner of Vista Way and Jefferson Street - ADP11-00002) – Establishment of a temporary outdoor nursery on a 4.3-acre commercial site most recently utilized as a vehicle sales facility. The temporary nursery will operate on the subject site for no more than 120 days, ceasing operations prior to August 1, 2011. Administrative approval on April 25, 2011 and the appeal period ends on May 5, 2011.

<u>City Business Tax Program (CBT)</u>

On June 23, 2010, the City Council authorized the City to participate in the State of California Franchise Tax Board City Business Tax program, which authorizes the State and City to exchange data related to businesses operating with the City limits. The

data exchange allows the City to cross-reference business information reported to the State with information reported to the City. This cross-reference helps ensure compliance with zoning and business license ordinances, and provides a comparison basis for gross revenues being reported.

Oceanside received the comparison results in December 2010 which identified over **11,100 "no-matches"** according to the State data. Staff was able to match 471 by EIN/SSN comparison. The remainder will require manual research. Typically the first year of this program allows the City and State to clean up their databases with changed or missing information.

City staff has commenced sending out letters to those businesses that are "no-matches", which appear to be predominantly home occupations. These letters are asking them to comply with the Oceanside Code Section 15.2 (1) regarding Business Licenses. They will have the opportunity to present support documentation if they feel they don't qualify under this legal requirement.
