Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission reviewed and took action on at their meeting on Monday, May 9, 2011.

<u>BEACHWALK LLC AND LEEDS LLC</u> – Adoption of Planning Commission Resolution Numbers 2011-P15 and 2011-P16 denying without prejudice REGULAR COASTAL PERMITS (RC10-00002, RC10-00010) and VARIANCES (V11-00001, V11-00002) for the conversion of an existing six-unit multi-family complex into two single-family detached residences on separate legal lots, respectively located at 817 and 819 South Pacific Street. *The Commission adopted the resolutions by a 4-1-1 vote (Neal – No, Balma – Abstain) (Bertheaud – Absent).* 

<u>PACIFIC VIEW CHARTER SCHOOL</u> – Consideration of a CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT (CUP11-00001) A request to amend the enrollment capacity from a maximum of 500 students to a maximum of 800 students for the existing Pacific View Charter School established and operating within Buildings 6 and 7 of the Venture Commerce Center located at 3660 and 3682 Ocean Ranch Blvd. *The Commission approved the project by a 6-0 vote (Bertheaud – Absent) and adopted the resolution and the call for review/appeal period ends on May 19, 2011.* 

<u>CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM</u> – Discussion and approval of proposed Capital Improvement Program (CIP) for FY 2011-2012 for the City of Oceanside. *The Commission approved the project by a 6-0 vote (Bertheaud – Absent) and adopted the resolution and the call for review/appeal period ends on May 19, 2011.*
