Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission reviewed and took action on at their meeting on Monday, June 13, 2011

PRO KIDS GOLF – Consideration of a DEVELOPMENT PLAN (D10-00008) and CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT (CUP10-00025) a request for approval to construct a 4,327-square foot clubhouse, golf practice area, and six-hole par-3 golf course for kids ages 7 to 17 immediately adjacent to the Oceanside Municipal Golf Course, and adjacent to Douglas Drive directly to the north. The Commission approved the project by a 6-0 vote (Bertheaud – Absent) and adopted the resolution and the call for review/appeal period ends on June 23, 2011.

<u>T-MOBILE AT 24-FITNESS</u> – Consideration of a CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT (CUP11-00003) to allow construction of a wireless telecommunication facility comprised of 16 panel antennas mounted on top of an existing commercial building and screened from public view with an Radio Frequency friendly material located at 4655 Frazee Road. *The Commission approved the project by a 6-0 vote (Bertheaud – Absent) and adopted the resolution and the call for review/appeal period ends on June 23, 2011.*

<u>TACO BELL REVISION</u> – Consideration of a DEVELOPMENT PLAN (D11-00001) to allow the demolition of an existing 2,862-square foot restaurant known as Taco Bell to permit the construction of a new 2,445-square foot Taco Bell located at 1940 Oceanside Boulevard. *This item has been continued to the July 11, 2011 public hearing.*

Introduction of an Ordinance for ZONE AMENDMENT (ZA11-00001) amending Articles 41 and 43 of the Oceanside Zoning Ordinance. – Second 24-month automatic Time Extensions for Development Plans, Conditional Use Permits, Variances, and Regular Coastal Permits. *The Commission approved the project by a 6-0 vote (Bertheaud – Absent) and adopted the resolution and the call for review/appeal period ends on June 23, 2011.*
