COUNCIL WEEKLY UPDATE

PLANNING DIVISION

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission reviewed and took action on at their meeting on Monday, July 11, 2011:

TACO BELL REVISION – Consideration of a DEVELOPMENT PLAN (D11-00001) to allow the demolition of an existing 2,862-square foot restaurant known as Taco Bell to permit the construction of a new 2,445-square foot Taco Bell located at 1940 Oceanside Boulevard. The Commission approved the project by a 4-2 vote (Martinek, Scrivener – No; Troisi – Absent) and adopted the resolution with modifications to conditions of approval and the call for review/appeal period ends on July 21, 2011.

KELLER ADDITION – Consideration of a REGULAR COASTAL PERMIT (RC10-00012) to allow an 84 square-foot bathroom addition to an existing residence located at 33 Saint Malo Beach. *The Commission approved the project by a 6-0 vote (Troisi – Absent) and adopted the resolution and the call for review/appeal period ends on July 21, 2011.*

1301 SOUTH PACIFIC STREET – Consideration of a REGULAR COASTAL PERMIT (RC11-00003) to permit a balcony extension to an existing duplex located at 1301 South Pacific St. *The Commission approved the project by a 6-0 vote (Troisi – Absent) and adopted the resolution and the call for review/appeal period ends on July 21, 2011.*

HENNENHOFER REMODEL – Consideration of a REGULAR COASTAL PERMIT (RC11-00001) for the remodel of a two-unit beachfront property located at 1303 S. Pacific St. *The Commission approved the project by a 6-0 vote (Troisi – Absent) and adopted the resolution and the call for review/appeal period ends on July 21, 201*

MACDONALD ADDITION – Consideration of a REGULAR COASTAL PERMIT (RC11-00004) to allow an existing open second story balcony to be enclosed at an existing residence located at 1639 South Pacific Street. *The Commission took no action on the project with a 3-3 vote (Martinek, Balma, Scrivener – No; Neal, Rosales, Ross – Yes; Troisi – Absent), item has been continued to the August 8, 2011 public hearing.*

City of Oceanside's Fleet Management Division Named to '100 Best Fleets'

The City of Oceanside's Fleet Management Division has once again made the list of 100 Best Fleets in North America for 2011, as selected by Government Fleet magazine. The 100 Best Fleets awards program recognizes leading fleets from across the country. The awards were announced at a national conference held in San Diego on June 8, 2011.

There are 38,000 public sector fleets in North America that are eligible for the award. In 2011, over 9000 applications were distributed to fleets identified as performing high-quality work in the industry.

The City of Oceanside has a centralized Fleet Division responsible for purchasing, maintaining, and servicing the majority of City vehicles. The division, led by Fleet Supervisor Jeffery Hart, maintains over 480 vehicles and equipment including utility trucks, police cars, fire apparatus and ambulances.

This is the fifth time in eight years that The Fleet Management Division has been recognized as one of the 100 Best Fleets in North America. This award highlights Fleet Management's continuing commitment to provide quality and competitive maintenance services to our customers in a timely and efficient manner, through collaboration of individual strengths, environmentally friendly options, and common goals, while always striving to improve.
