COUNCIL WEEKLY UPDATE

PLANNING DIVISION

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission reviewed and took action on at their meeting on Monday, August 8, 2011:

<u>MacDonald Addition</u> – Consideration of a Regular Coastal Permit (RC11-00004) to allow an existing open second-story balcony to be enclosed at an existing residence located at 1639 South Pacific Street. *The Commission denied the project by a 3-4 vote (Balma, Martinek, Troisi, Scrivener – No). The call for review/appeal period ends on August 18, 2011.*

<u>Tri-City Hospital Medical Office Building</u> – Consideration of a Development Plan (D11-00002) for the improvement of a 5.13-acre area within the Tri-City Medical Center property at 4002 Vista Way with a 57,476-square-foot (3-story) medical office building and associated site improvements; and Conditional Use Permit (CUP11-00002) to allow the proposed building's height (64 ft.) to exceed the maximum allowed (50 ft.) within the subject zoning district. *The Commission approved the project by a 7-0 vote and adopted the resolution. The call for review/appeal period ends on August 18, 2011.*

Sunshine Brooks Theater Update and Timeline

The recommendation for the Property Use of Sunshine Brooks Theater is to contract with a new operator, Oceanside Theater Company. The recommendation of an RFP review committee is supported by staff and was approved unanimously by the Arts Commission on June 6, 2011. The item will be voted on by the Parks and Recreation Commission on Thursday, August 11, 2011, and will then proceed to City Council on August 31, 2011, for final approval. The current operator, New Vision Theater Company is currently operating month-to-month through September 30, 2011, with the expectation to turn over the facility on October 1, 2011, should the recommendation be approved. A decision on August 31, 2011, will allow appropriate timing for all parties involved to plan and implement the next steps in the process. Staff anticipates having a new contract ready for City Council approval at an October City Council meeting.

New Biotech Company Comes to Town

Gilead Sciences has purchased a clinical manufacturing plant from Genentech's parent company Roche just south of the Genentech's main campus in Oceanside at 4049 Avenida de la Plata.

This is good news for Oceanside. The addition of Gilead Sciences to Oceanside will add another brand name bio-tech company to the City. Gilead will take 55 scientists from the Genentech plant to continue work on the experimental drugs and may add additional staffing in the future.
