# **PLANNING DIVISION**

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission will review at their meeting on Monday, August 22, 2011:

<u>MacDonald Addition</u> – Adoption of Planning Commission Resolution No. 2011-P25 denying Regular Coastal Permit (RC11-00004) to allow an existing open second story balcony to be enclosed at an existing residence located at 1639 South Pacific Street.

Rancho Del Oro Village XII Master Plan Amendment – Consideration of a Development Plan (D11-00003). An amendment to the Rancho Del Oro PRD Master Plan to add RDO Village XII and to establish development regulations for residential uses on the approximately 28-acre subject property located at the northwest corner of College Boulevard and Old Grove Road. – *This item has been continued to the September 12, 2011 public hearing.*
