#### Concert In The Park

Neighborhood Services and the Friends of Oceanside Parks will be hosting a free concert on Friday, August 26, at Rancho Del Oro Park. The event is free, however, an opportunity drawing will be held to raise funds for future events.

#### Oceanside Remembers 9/11

The Volunteer Driving Program has 15 active volunteer drivers and provided 110 one-way trips to 26 senior residents during the month of July. These trips are to medical appointments, pharmacies, and grocery stores. The average age of our senior riders is 83 years.
