Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission will review at their meeting on Monday, September 19, 2011:

<u>MacDonald Residence</u> – Adoption of Planning Commission Resolution No. 2011-P25 denying Regular Coastal Permit (RC11-00004) to allow an existing open second story balcony to be enclosed at an existing residence located at 1639 South Pacific Street. The project site is zoned RT (Residential Tourist District) and is within the Townsite Neighborhood and the Coastal Zone.

<u>Rancho Del Oro Village XII Master Plan Amendment</u> – Consideration of a Development Plan (D11-00003); an amendment to the Rancho Del Oro PRD Master Plan to add RDO Village XII and to establish development regulations for residential uses on the approximately 28-acre subject property located at the northwest corner of College Boulevard and Old Grove Road. *Staff is recommending approval.*

<u>Altman Addition</u> – Consideration of a Regular Coastal Permit (RC10-00009) and Variance (V11-0004) for an addition to an existing single-family residence constituting a third story over a basement at 1823 S. Pacific Street. Situated within the South Oceanside Neighborhood Planning Area and the Coastal Zone, the subject property bears a land use designation of Single-Family Detached Residential (SDF-R) and a zoning designation of Single-Family Residential (R-1). *Staff is recommending denial.*
