Listed below are the items that the Planning Commission reviewed and took action on at their meeting on Monday, September 19, 2011:

<u>MacDonald Addition</u> – Adoption of Planning Commission Resolution No. 2011-P25 denying Regular Coastal Permit RC11-00004 to allow an existing open second story balcony to be enclosed at an existing residence located at 1639 South Pacific Street. *The Commission adopted the resolution by a 5-1 vote. The call for review/appeal period ends on September 29, 2011.*

Rancho Del Oro Village XII Master Plan Amendment – Consideration of a Development Plan D11-00003 to amend the Rancho Del Oro Planned Residential Development Master Plan to add Rancho Del Oro Village XII and to establish development regulations for residential uses on approximately 28 acres located at the northwest corner of College Boulevard and Old Grove Road. *The Commission approved the amendment by a 6-0 vote and adopted the resolution. The call for review/appeal period ends on September 29, 2011.*

<u>Altman Addition</u> – Consideration of a Regular Coastal Permit RC10-00009 and Variance V11-00004 for an addition to an existing single-family residence, constituting a third story over a basement located at 1823 South Pacific Street. *This item is continued to the next Planning Commission meeting on September 26, 2011.*
