Listed below are the items that the Planning Commission reviewed and took action on at their meeting on Monday, September 26, 2011:

<u>Altman Addition</u> – Consideration of a Regular Coastal Permit RC10-00009 and Variance V11-00004 for an addition to an existing single-family residence constituting a third story over a basement located at 1823 South Pacific Street. *The Commission approved the project by a 7-0 vote and adopted the resolution. The call for review/appeal period ends on October 6, 2011.*

Oceanside Vineyard Church – Consideration of a Conditional Use Permit CUP11-00017 to permit a religious facility within two existing industrial suites located at 3800 Oceanic Drive, Suite 113-115. *The Commission approved the project by a 7-0 vote and adopted the resolution. The call for review/appeal period ends on October 6, 2011.*

<u>New Birth Baptist Church</u> – Consideration of a Conditional Use Permit CUP11-00018 to permit a religious facility within an existing office building located at 2251 Mesa Drive. *This item is continued to the October 10, 2011 Planning Commission meeting.*

Family Self-Sufficiency Coordinator Funding Award

The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development has notified the City of an award of \$137,360 to pay the salaries of two Family Self-Sufficiency (FSS) Coordinators in the Neighborhood Services Department for Calendar Year 2012. The FSS Program has been available to households participating in the City's Housing Choice Voucher (Section 8) Program since 1993. Families in the program execute a contract that specifies goals and services. The contract requires that all members become independent of welfare and maintain suitable employment. The FSS Coordinators ensure that the program participants are linked to the supportive services they need to achieve self-sufficiency.
