PLANNING DIVISION

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission will review at their meeting on Monday, October 24, 2011:

<u>7-Eleven at 308 S. Coast Highway</u> – Consideration of a Regular Coastal Permit (RC11-00006) and Conditional Use Permit (CUP11-00011) to permit establishment of a convenience market with "off-site" sales of beer and wine within an existing 2,860-squarefoot structure, and construction of associated site improvements on the property located at 308 S. Coast Highway. *Staff is recommending approval.*

<u>Wermer's Remodel</u> – Consideration of a Regular Coastal Permit (RC11-00008) for the remodel of an existing single-family residence located at 1949 S. Pacific St. *Staff is recommending approval.*

<u>Diego Hills Public Charter, Inc.</u> – Consideration of a Conditional Use Permit (CUP10-00030) to establish and operate a 9-12 grade Resource Center/Charter School within an existing 19,553-square-foot commercial retail tenant space. The proposed Resource Center/Charter School would be established in two phases, with phase one having a maximum enrollment of 200 students and phase two increasing the enrollment capacity to a maximum of 500 students. The site is located east of Horne Street and south of Civic Center Drive, within the northern portion of the Mission Square located at 320 N. Horne Street. *Staff is recommending approval.*

<u>Mudge Residence</u> – Consideration of a Regular Coastal Permit Revision (RC11-00014 Rev. RC-2-08) to amend the approving Planning Commission Resolution (PC2009-P49) and establishing revetment findings as required by the Local Coastal Program for an approved but unconstructed new two-story-over-a-basement single-family residence located at 1721 South Pacific Street. *Staff is recommending approval.*

6:00 pm – **Reduce** (eliminating poor product design and marine debris, such as plastic bags and polystyrene take-out containers)
