Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission reviewed and took action on at their meeting on Monday, November 7, 2011:

7-ELEVEN AT 308 S. COAST HWY – Adoption of Planning Commission Resolution No. 2011-P37 denying Regular Coastal Permit (RC11-00006) and Conditional Use Permit (CUP11-00011) to permit establishment of a convenience market with "off-site" sales of beer and wine within an existing 2,860-square-foot structure, and construction of associated site improvements, on the property located at 308 S. Coast Highway. *The Commission adopted the resolution by a 5-1 vote (Balma – No, Martinek – Absent). The call for review/appeal period ends on November 17, 2011.*

WERMERS REMODEL – Consideration of a REGULAR COASTAL PERMT (RC11-00008) for the remodel of an existing single-family residence located at 1949 S. Pacific St. *The Commission approved the project by a 6-0 vote (Martinek – Absent) and adopted the resolution. The call for review/appeal period ends on November 17, 2011.*

PI AZZA D'ORO M XED USE PLAN REVI SI ON – Consideration of a DEVELOPMENT PLAN (D11-00011) and CONDITIONAL USE PERMT (CUP11-00020) to amend the Piazza D'Oro Mixed Use Plan in a manner that would allow the establishment of Medical Office-type uses in up to 50 percent of the retail building square footage or approximately 2, 694 square feet max. The site is located north of Vista Way, west of Rancho Del Oro Road within the central portion of the Piazza D'Oro Complex located at 3400 and 3401 Piazza D'Oro Way. *The Commission approved the project by a 6-0 vote (Martinek – Absent) and adopted the resolution. The call for review/appeal period ends on November 17, 2011.*

811 – 815 SOUTH PACIFIC STREET DUPLEX CONVERSIONS – Consideration of REGULAR COASTAL PERMITS (RC11-00009/RC11-000010/RC11-00011) for the conversion of three existing single-family residences to duplexes at 811, 813 and 815 South Pacific Street. *The Commission approved the project by a 6-0 vote (Martinek – Absent) and adopted the resolution. The call for review/appeal period ends on November 17, 2011.*
