<u>Damkin SFD</u> – Consideration of a Regular Coastal Permit (RC11-00005) to permit the demolition of an existing single-family residence to allow the construction of three residential units located at 2003 South Tremont Street. *The Commission approved the project by a 6-0 vote (Balma – Absent) and adopted the resolution. The call for review/appeal period ends on November 24, 2011.*

<u>The Ho Tentative Parcel Map</u> – Consideration of a Tentative Parcel Map (P10-00003) and Conditional Use Permits (CUP10-00023 and CUP10-00024) for a two-lot residential subdivision of a .83-acre site located at the southeast corner of Fire Mountain Drive and Ivy. *The Commission approved the project by a 5-1 vote (Troisi – No, Balma – Absent) and adopted the resolution. The call for review/appeal period ends on November 24, 2011.*
