COUNCIL WEEKLY UPDATE

December 15, 2011

PLANNING DIVISION

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission reviewed and took action on at their meeting on Monday, December 12, 2011:

<u>West Residence Addition</u> – Consideration of a Regular Coastal Permit (RC11-00015) for the addition of a 52-square-foot entrance to the existing beachfront residence at 2011 S. Pacific St. *The Commission approved the project by a 6-0 vote (Troisi – absent) and adopted the resolution. The call for review/appeal period ends on <i>December 22, 2011.*

<u>The Hahn Parcel Map</u> – Consideration of a Tentative Parcel Map (P-7-08) and Conditional Use Permit (C-22-08) for a two-lot subdivision on a .50-acre parcel situated at the southwest of the intersection of Fire Mountain Drive and private road Victoria Lane within the Fire Mountain Neighborhood. *The Commission approved the project by a 6-0 vote (Troisi – absent) and adopted the resolution. The call for review/appeal period ends on December 22, 2011.*

El Corazon Green Waste Composting Facility – Consideration of a Development Plan (D09-00004) and Conditional Use Permit (CUP09-00011) for a request to relocate the existing El Corazon Compost facility located within the centralized area of the El Corazon Master Planned Area to the southwest entry at 3210 Oceanside Boulevard. The Commission approved the project by a 6-0 vote (Troisi – absent) and adopted the resolution. The call for review/appeal period ends on December 22, 2011.

<u>L.A. Fitness</u> – Consideration of a Conditional Use Permit (CUP11-00015) to allow a large-scale personal improvement service in an existing commercial building at 2335 Vista Way. *The Commission approved the project by a 6-0 vote (Troisi – absent) and adopted the resolution. The call for review/appeal period ends on December 22, 2011.*

Candlelight Vigils

Save Our Streets is leading Candlelight Vigils in four of our neighborhoods on the evening of Tuesday, December 20, 2011, to remember all victims of violence in Oceanside and to call for peace and unity throughout the City in 2012.

Vigil sites will be: the corner of Arthur Avenue and Gold Drive; Libby Lake Community Center (back parking lot); Joe Balderrama Park (basketball court area); and the Crown Heights Community Resource Center. Activities at the first 3 sites will begin at 6:00 p.m. In Crown Heights, attendees will gather at the Campfire USA building on the corner of Division and Brooks Streets and leave that site at 5:45 p.m. for a peace walk along the sidewalk down to the Resource Center.

Alex Road Skatepark Project

On October 20, 2010, the City Council approved staff to apply for a Land and Water Conservation Fund (LWCF) grant in the amount of \$400,000 for the construction of Alex Road Skatepark; the third skatepark in the Skatepark Master Plan. Staff has been notified that the City of Oceanside has been awarded the grant funds. Total project costs are estimated at approximately \$800,000. The Parks CIP budget has anticipated a match and an additional \$25,000 is available from a previous Tony Hawk Grant Award. With the LWCF grant award, a total of \$800,000 is available to fund the project.

Annual maintenance of the park is projected to be slightly below \$2,000 per fiscal year. The Neighborhood Services Department is developing a sponsorship program for recreation facilities and events. Staff will be soliciting skatepark industry sponsors through this program for a five-year commitment toward the park's maintenance. Staff anticipates bringing the acceptance of funds, an LWCF grant contract, and sponsorship commitments to the City Council sometime in March 2012.
