Planning Commission

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission will review at their meeting on Monday, January 11, 2010:

<u>Q Restaurant and Sports Bar</u> – to allow live entertainment and dancing within the existing Q Restaurant and Sports Bar located at 2725 Vista Way. *Staff is recommending approval.*

<u>Surfside Animal Hospital</u> – to permit the establishment and operation of an Animal Hospital within an existing 3,768-square-foot building located at 3876 Mission Avenue. **Staff is recommending approval.**

<u>Enright Townhomes REV09</u> – to permit the remodel of an existing duplex to add 168 square feet of shade structure to the second story with a 300-square-foot sunroom with deck above, and a new rooftop deck area above the proposed sunroom located at 1213 South Pacific Street. *Staff is recommending approval.*

<u>Pacific Coast Business Park Phase II</u> – for the construction of three industrial warehouse and office buildings located south of Rocky Point Drive and east of Avenida Del Oro. **Staff is recommending approval.**

<u>Pilgrim Creek</u> – for a 7-lot residential subdivision on a 2.13-acre site located west of the terminus of Concho Circle and east of Foss Lake Habitat Area. **Staff is recommending denial.**

<u>Census 2010</u>

The U.S. Census Bureau will begin using the former community computer center space in January as a testing and training center for Census 2010 workers. Census 2010 will be conducted by mail but there will still be extensive need for part-time workers to process returns and to follow up on households that do not respond. The Census Bureau wants to ensure that every person is counted and particularly wants to hire persons from neighborhoods considered "hard to count." Bilingual applicants are particularly needed.
