#### **Planning Commission**

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission reviewed and took action on at their meeting on Monday, January 11, 2010:

Q Restaurant and Sports Bar – to allow live entertainment and dancing with the existing Q Restaurant and Sports Bar, from the hours of 8 p.m. to 1 a.m. Thursday through Sunday, located at 2725 Vista Way. *The Commission approved the project by a 7-0 vote and adopted the resolution and the call for review/appeal period ends on January 21, 2010.* 

<u>Surfside Animal Hospital</u> – to permit the establishment and operation of an Animal Hospital within an existing 3,768-square foot building located at 3876 Mission Avenue. *The Commission approved the project by a 7-0 vote and adopted the resolution and the call for review/appeal period ends on January 21, 2010.* 

Enright Townhomes REV09 – to permit the remodel of an existing duplex to add 168 square feet of shade structure to the second story with a 300-square foot sunroom with deck above, and a new rooftop deck area above the proposed sunroom located at 1213 South Pacific Street. The Commission approved the project by a 6-1 vote and adopted the resolution and the call for review/appeal period ends on January 21, 2010.

<u>Pacific Coast Business Park Phase II</u> – for the construction of three industrial warehouse and office buildings located south of Rocky Drive and east of Avenida Del Oro. *The Commission approved the project by a 7-0 vote and adopted the resolution and the call for review/appeal period ends on January 21, 2010.* 

<u>Pilgrim Creek</u> – for a 7-lot residential subdivision on a 2.13-acre site located west of the terminus of Concho Circle and east of Foss Lake Habitat Area. *The Commission denied the project by a 6-1 vote and adopted the resolution and the call for review/appeal period ends on January 21, 2010.* 

# <u>Health Survey Being Conducted in Oceanside by National Center for Health</u> Statistics

The City has been advised that a The National Center for Health Statistics is conducting a major study of the health of persons living in the United States. Oceanside has been selected as one of the survey locations. The survey is used to gather information to assess the health and nutrition status of children and adults and their needs for health care. The survey is party of the U.S. Public Health Services continuing study of the nation's health. Data are collected through household interviews and standardized medical examinations in the mobile examination center.

The survey will be conducted in San Diego County from December 15, 2009 - March 6, 2010. They expect to have 445 people from San Diego County in the survey. Interviewers will be calling on designated households. The agency is advising appropriate officials of the local governments, law enforcement agencies, and medical and dental societies before they begin operations in the event that we receive inquiries.
