1443 S. Pacific Street Remodel – To permit the remodel of an existing duplex to add 1,217 square feet of habitable space on the third story in lieu of the existing roof deck and new deck area to the westward portion of the home. *Staff is recommending approval.*

The Oceanside Recovery Center – To change the land use designation from Single-Family Dwelling Residential (SFD-R) to Private Institutional (PI) and change the zoning designation from Single-Family Residential (RS) to Public & Semi-Public (PS) all with an Historic Overlay (H) in order to allow the construction of a two-story 16,591-square-foot, 59-bed, 24-hour nonmedical care drug and alcohol recovery center for men on a 1.00-acre site located North of Chapter Way, south of San Luis Rey Mobile Home Park, and east of the San Luis Rey Parish Church. *Staff is recommending denial*.
