Planning Commission

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission will review at their meeting on March 8, 2010:

West Coast Tire & Wheel – Consideration of a DEVELOPMENT (D-15-92Rev05), CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT (C-9-95Rev05) and REGULAR COASTAL PERMIT (RC-2-95Rev05) to allow the addition of 3,508 square feet to the existing auto shop located at 1434 South Coast Highway. ***Staff is recommending denial.***

Administrative Approval:

Wick Residence – An ADMINISTRATIVE COASTAL PERMIT (ACP09-00007) for the demolition of an existing 1,518-square foot residence with a single-car garage, to enable construction of a new 1,647-square foot residence with a 400-square foot two-car garage located at 1533 Loretta Street. ***Administrative approval on March 1, 2010 and the appeal period ends on March 11, 2010.***

Temporary Plant Shutdown

The Reverse Osmosis Water Treatment Plant will be shutdown for two days beginning Wednesday, March 10 and Thursday, March 11, due to fumigation for termites. Work will commence at approximately 8:00 am on Wednesday, March 10. The Weese filtration plant will increase flows to meet demands during that time-period. The RO Plant should be back on line, late in the afternoon, March 12.
