### **Planning Commission**

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission will review at their meeting on Monday, March 22, 2010:

Ocean Terrace Professional Center – Consideration of a Development Plan (D10-00001) to permit exterior elevation changes to an existing building located at 3605 Vista Way. ***Staff is recommending approval.***

Cassidy Cove – Consideration of a Tentative Parcel Map (P-5-08), Development Plan (D-6-08) and Regular Coastal Permit (RC-5-08) to permit the construction of an eight-unit residential condominium complex with 10 associated covered parking stalls to a newly created parcel located at 301 Cassidy Street. ***Staff is recommending approval.***

### **Crown Heights Free Clinic**

On Sunday, March 28th from 8:30 am to 3:00 pm the Tzu Chi Foundation will be offering a free medical/dental clinic to neighborhood residents at the Crown Heights Community Resource Center. Tzu Chi is an international Buddhist charitable organization that originated in Taiwan. The California branch is a 501C3 non-profit organization that operates some free health clinics in the Los Angeles area. Tzu Chi does a lot of international/disaster relief work and currently has a team working in Haiti. They have provided this free service in Crown Heights three times in the last five years. They are very well organized and bring a large dental van and a number of doctors and nurses from L.A. with them for this event.
