

## COUNCIL WEEKLY UPDATE

March 25, 2010

### Planning Commission

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission reviewed and took action on at their meeting on March 22, 2010:

Ocean Terrace Professional Center – Consideration of a Development Plan (D10-00001) to permit exterior elevation changes to an existing building located at 3605 Vista Way. ***The Commission approved the project by a 4-2 vote (Bertheaud – Absent) and adopted the resolution and the call for review/appeal period ends on April 1, 2010.***

Cassidy Cove – Consideration of a Tentative Parcel Map (P-5-08), Development Plan (D-6-08) and Regular Coastal Permit (RC-5-08) to permit the construction of an eight-unit residential condominium complex with 10 associated covered parking stalls to a newly created parcel located at 301 Cassidy Street. ***The Commission approved the project by a 6-0 vote (Bertheaud – Absent) and adopted the resolution and the call for review/appeal period ends on April 1, 2010.***

### Water Conservation

We are pleased to report that water usage in Oceanside was down by approximately 23% comparing February 2010 to the same month a year ago. While some of that decrease in water usage is attributable to the recent rainstorms, our residents and businesses should be recognized for their water conservation commitment.

Overall, we have reduced water consumption by approximately 10% since July 1, compared to the same period a year earlier.
