#### **Good Turnout at Free Medical Clinic**

Four hundred and seventeen people received medical services through the Tzu Chi free medical clinic at the Crown Heights Community Resource Center on Sunday, March 28th. Ninety-two volunteers worked the event, including 23 medical staff and 29 assistants from the Tzu Chi Foundation and 40 volunteers from Community Resource Center programs, the Crown Heights neighborhood, and area colleges. Among the services provided were Internal Medicine, Pediatrics, Pharmacy, Dental Services, Oriental Medicine (Acupuncture etc) and Nursing Consultations. An additional 36 people received free haircuts. Census 2010 staff were present throughout the day to promote full participation in Census activities.
