#### Planning Commission

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission will review at their meeting on Monday, April 12, 2010:

<u>Oceanside Mixed Martial Arts</u> – Consideration of a Conditional Use Permit (CUP10-00003) to allow the use of martial arts training, instruction, and tournaments within an existing commercial suite, located at 318 North Horne Street. *Staff is recommending approval.* 

<u>75 St. Malo Beach</u> – Consideration of a Regular Coastal Permit (RC09-00007) to allow a 62-square foot kitchen addition to an existing single-family home, located at 75 Saint Malo Beach. *Staff is recommending approval.* 

#### City Wins Award

The San Diego Chapter of the American Public Works Association has awarded a 2010 "Project of the Year" award to the City and to the Water Utilities Department in recognition of the recently completed improvements to the La Salina Sewer Treatment Plant. The award will be presented to the City at an APWA luncheon on May 13, 2010.

The recent improvements at the La Salina Plant included a \$2 million upgrade and retrofit to a plant that dates back to the 1940's.
