

COUNCIL WEEKLY UPDATE

April 15, 2010

Planning Commission

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission reviewed and took action on at their meeting on Monday, April 12, 2010:

Oceanside Mixed Martial Arts – Consideration of a Conditional Use Permit (CUP10-00003) to allow the use of martial arts training, instruction, and tournaments within an existing commercial suite, located at 318 North Horne Street. ***The Commission approved the project by a 6-0 vote (Bertheaud – Absent) and adopted the resolution and the call for review/appeal period ends on April 22, 2010.***

75 St. Malo Beach – Consideration of a Regular Coastal Permit (RC09-00007) to allow a 62-square foot kitchen addition to an existing single-family home, located at 75 Saint Malo Beach. ***The Commission approved the project by a 6-0 vote (Bertheaud – Absent) and adopted the resolution and the call for review/appeal period ends on April 22, 2010.***

Family Self-Sufficiency Coordinator Funding Award

The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development has notified the City of an award of \$136,000 to pay the salaries of two Family Self-Sufficiency (FSS) Coordinators in the Neighborhood Services Department for Calendar Year 2010. The FSS Program has been available to households participating in the City's Housing Choice Voucher (Section 8) Program since 1993. Families in the program execute a contract that specifies goals and services; the contract requires that all members become independent of welfare and maintain suitable employment. The FSS Coordinators ensure that the program participants are linked to the supportive services they need to achieve self-sufficiency.
