### **COUNCIL WEEKLY UPDATE**

## April 29, 2010

### **Planning Commission**

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission reviewed and took action on at their meeting on Monday, April 26, 2010:

The Fellowship Center - Consideration of a General Plan Amendment (GPA-3-07), Zone Amendment (ZA-2-07), Development Plan (D-6-07), Conditional Use Permit (C-9-07), and Historic Permit (H-3-07) to change the land use designation from Single-Family Dwelling Residential (SFD-R) to Private Institutional (PI) and change the zoning designation from Single-Family Residential (RS) to Public & Semi-Public (PS) all with an Historic overlay (H) in order to allow the construction of a two-story, 16,591-square foot, 59-bed 24-hour Non-Medical Care Drug and Alcohol Recovery Center on a 1.00-acre site. *The Commission recommended denial of the project to the City Council by a vote of 5-1 (Bertheaud – absent) and adopted the resolution.* 

# Administrative Approval

Oceans – A request for approval of an Administrative Conditional Use Permit (ACUP09-00020) for the installation of a co-user wireless communication facility within an existing commercial building rooftop cupola located at 805 College Boulevard. *Administrative approval on April 26, 2010, and the appeal period ends on May 6, 2010.* 

Josh's Boars Nest – Consideration of an Administrative Conditional Use Permit (ACUP10-00002) to allow motorcycle sales in association with an existing motorcycle repair shop located at 3207 Roymar Road. *Administrative approval on April 26, 2010, and the appeal period ends on May 6, 2010.*
