

COUNCIL WEEKLY UPDATE

May 6, 2010

Planning Commission

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission will review at their meeting on Monday, May 10, 2010:

Cavalier Mobile Estates – Consideration of a Tentative Map (T-1-09) and Regular Coastal Permit (RC-5-09) for a 348-lot residential subdivision of an existing mobile home park on an approximately 44-acre site located at 1225 Oceanside Boulevard.

Staff is recommending denial.

This item has been continued to a future public hearing.

Former South Coast Quarry Amended Reclamation Plan – Consideration of an Amendment to an existing Reclamation Plan (RMA-1-00 Revision 05) and Subsequent Environmental Impact Report on a 104-acre site located in the northeast portion of the City of Carlsbad and the southwestern portion of the City of Oceanside south of State Route 78 and west of College Boulevard. **Staff is recommending approval.**

Administrative Approval

Clearwire @ 3570 Sky Haven Lane – A request for approval of an Administrative Conditional Use Permit (ACUP09-00008) for installation of co-located wireless telecommunication equipment upon and adjacent to previously approved and currently operational wireless communication facilities. The existing facilities are located in an otherwise-undeveloped portion of the Rancho Calevero Mobile Home Park primarily used for guest parking. **Administrative approval on May 3, 2010, and the appeal period ends on May 13, 2010.**

Mission Avenue Improvements

The City of Oceanside held a public workshop on January 7, 2010, to discuss various options for improvements to Mission Avenue. These alternatives included; one-way streets on Mission, Seagaze and Pier View, two lanes or four lanes on Mission, and roundabouts or traffic circles. The general consensus and preferred alternative, from a circulation and overall visual standpoint, was the option that took Mission Avenue down to two lanes, one-way west bound from Clementine to Cleveland Streets and converting Seagaze Drive to two lanes one-way east bound to Clementine. This would allow the sidewalks on Mission Avenue to be widened to accommodate additional street amenities: landscaping, canopy trees, outdoor dining opportunities, bulb outs at intersections to allow for pedestrians to safely cross Mission Avenue, additional parking and to improved way finding and public art opportunities.

A second public workshop will be held on May 17, 2010, **from 6:00 – 8:00 p.m. in the City Council Chambers, located at 300 North Coast Highway.** This workshop is intended to review the overall concept, but primarily to focus on the potential improvements to Mission Avenue. Please plan to come, review the results of the analysis and provide your input.

Grant Application

The Oceanside Community Safety Partnership will be submitting an application for funding for the City under the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention FY 2010 Youth Gang Prevention and Intervention Program. The focus of the grant application will be on sustaining and increasing youth after school programming at the Joe Balderrama Recreation Center in Eastside. Federal funding received by Vista Community Clinic for the Junior REACH program currently operating at JBRC will end in December this year. The grant is for funding up to \$325,000 to be used over an 18 month period and requires replication of a model program from a list provided in the grant application. It is a very competitive grant as a maximum of 10 grants will be issued nationwide.
