## **Planning Commission**

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission will review at their meeting on May 24, 2010:

<u>Cavalier Mobile Estates</u> – Consideration of a Tentative Map (T-1-09), and Regular Coastal Permit (RC-5-09) for a 348-lot residential subdivision of an existing mobile home park on an approximately 44-acre site located at 1225 Oceanside Blvd. The Cavalier Mobile Home Park is located south of Oceanside Blvd., immediately west of Interstate 5, north and significantly down slope of Laguna Street, is transected by Loma Alta Creek which runs east to west through the center of the mobile home park. **Staff is recommending denial.** 

<u>The Cove Canyon Bluff Tentative Parcel Map</u> – Consideration of a Tentative Parcel Map (P-11-08), Development Plan (D-16-08), and Conditional Use Permits (C-39-08 & C-40-08) for a three-lot residential subdivision on a 1.14-acre parcel situated immediately west of Avocado Road, north of Ivy Road beyond two existing parcels, east of Downs Street beyond two existing parcels at 1869 Avocado Road within the Fire Mountain Neighborhood. *Staff is recommending approval.* 

The Cove Canyon Strand Tentative Parcel Map – Consideration of a Tentative Parcel Map (P-12-08), Development Plan (D-17-08), and Conditional Use Permits (C-41-08 & C-42-08) for a three-lot residential subdivision on a 1.08-acre parcel situated immediately north and east of Ivy Road, and just south of the intersection of Downs Street and Ivy Road at 1852 Ivy Road within the Fire Mountain Neighborhood. *Staff is recommending approval.*

Clear Wireless @ 2215 Mesa Drive – A request for approval of an Administrative Conditional Use Permit (ACUP09-00009) for the installation of a co-user wireless communication facility within an existing commercial office building located at 2215 Mesa Drive. Administrative approval on May 17, 2010 and the appeal period ends on May 27, 2010.
