Local Election Night Results

In order to make sure our citizens have access to our local election night results, specifically our two items being the election of a councilmember and Proposition K – the Charter measure, the results as they are received will be displayed on the City's Web site and on KOCT TV. These will be the numbers that have, in the past, been broadcast from the Council Chambers at the City's Election Central.

As was done in November 2008, there will be no Election Central due to the fact that the results are so slow to come in. In years past, many have worked for hours waiting for the final results at Election Central, into the wee hours of the morning. Rather, with

this election, we will return to the electronic display of results used in the 2008 General Election. As the numbers are counted, the displays will change with those updates.

Eastside Neighborhood Clean Up

A community clean up is scheduled for Friday, June 11th, from 8:00 am to 12:00 pm (noon) in the Eastside Neighborhood. This event is being coordinated by the Neighborhood Services Department and the Eastside Neighborhood Association. Over 300 Marines from Camp Pendleton's Center for Naval Aviation Technical Training Marine Unit will also be participating. Large trash disposal bins are being provided by Waste Management of North County. Clean up volunteers will meet at Joe Balderrama Park located at San Diego and Bush Streets starting at 7:30 am. Lunch will be provided for participants at the end of the event.

Annual Citywide Weed Abatement Program

The Code Enforcement Office coordinates the annual private-property weed abatement notification program. Owners of affected parcels are required to clear hazardous vegetation a minimum of 100 feet from structures, 50 feet from improved property lines, and 10 feet from roadways.
