Planning Commission

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission will review at their meeting on Monday, June 14, 2010:

Veterans Association of North County – Consideration of a Conditional Use Permit (C-7-09) to permit the establishment of a Veterans Association of North County Club/Lodge within an existing City owned building located at 1617 Mission Avenue. ***Staff is recommending approval.***

Verizon @ Five/78 – Consideration of a Conditional Use Permit (C-23-08) for the construction and operation of two telecommunication antennas concealed within two proposed parking lot light standards with associated equipment located at 1501 Kelly Street. ***Staff is recommending approval.***

Transportation Commission

Listed below are the items that the Transportation Commission will review at their meeting on June 15, 2010:

- Recommendation to install a five-minute loading zone adjacent to the Harney Sushi restaurant.
- Proposed stop control on Summerhill Drive at Muirwood Drive.

- Approval of the recommended concept plan for Mission Avenue between Horne Street and Cleveland Street.
- Proposed all-way stop control at the intersection of Laurel Street and San Diego Street.
- Proposed reverse angle parking on Tremont Street between Mission Avenue and Civic Center Drive.
