<u>Verizon @ Five/78 C-23-08</u> – For the construction and operation of two telecommunication antennas concealed within two proposed parking lot light standards with associated equipment located at 1501 Kelly Street. *The Commission approved the project by a 6-1 (Bertheaud – No) vote and adopted the resolution and the call for review/appeal period ends on June 24, 2010.*
