HUD Approves Revitalization Strategy

The Crown Heights - Eastside Neighborhood Revitalization Strategy Area (NRSA) Plan has been approved by the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Los Angeles Field Office. The approval notice will come with the annual funding agreement for the Community Development Block Grant Program in the City. Official implementation of the NRSA Plan will begin after July 1 through a partnership of the City, neighborhood residents and Community HousingWorks, although some projects in the plan are already underway and some capital improvement projects have been completed. Activities will continue under the 2010-2015 Consolidated Plan for Housing and Community Development.

Senior Services Staff On Panel for "Hunger In Oceanside, a Growing Concern"

The Oceanside Charitable Foundation, is hosting a community forum on Wednesday, June 30, 2010, from 6:00 – 7: 30 pm. It will be held at MiraCosta College – the Little Theater (Rm. 3601) on the quad in the center of campus, 1 Barnard Drive, Oceanside. According to Tom Nunan, chair of the Oceanside Charitable Foundation, Oceanside community leaders have identified access to food as the most critical health need in the community. The Oceanside Charitable Foundation will host a community forum to learn about this issue and lay a foundation for solutions. A panel of experts will present background information on the changing nature of the hunger problem in Oceanside and what is needed to make a difference. To date, the panel includes moderator Alison St. John, award winning journalist at KPBS and new host of KOCT's Journalist Roundtable program; John Criswell, Executive Director, San Diego Hunger Coalition; Vino Mitra, Nutrition Services Director, Oceanside Unified School District; Maureen Fleming, Supervisor, Oceanside Senior Center; and Caroline Wessel, Program Director, Catholic Charities.
