#### Stimulus Money Makes Difference in Oceanside

The City Council awarded in 2009 a CDBG-Recovery Act grant of \$72,470 to North County Health Services (NCHS) for OB-Gyn ultrasound equipment at the Loma Alta and Mission Mesa clinics. This grant in turn made possible a recent grant of \$125,000 from an anonymous donor; these new funds will provide additional equipment and staff training that will allow NCHS to offer general medicine ultrasounds for adults. The Loma Alta health center will serve as the ultrasound hub for North County clinics including patients from NCHS, Vista Community Clinic and the Neighborhood Health Center in Escondido. With this service and the OB-Gyn ultrasound equipment the City funded, NCHS is able to provide comprehensive ultrasound services for community clinic patients.

#### **Concert in the Park**

The Arts Commission and Parks & Recreation are teaming up to bring music to our parks this summer.
