Planning Commission

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission reviewed and took action on at their meeting on Monday, July 26, 2010:

Former South Coast Quarry Amended Reclamation Plan - Consideration of an Amendment to an existing RECLAMATION PLAN (RMA-1-00 Revision 05) and Subsequent Environmental Impact Report on a 104-acre site located in the northeast portion of the City of Carlsbad and the southwestern portion of the City of Oceanside south of State Route 78 and west of College Boulevard – *The Commission approved the project by a 5-2 vote (Troisi, Balma – No) and adopted the resolution and the call for review/appeal period ends on August 5, 2010.*

Pepper Tree Revision - Consideration of a DEVELOPMENT PLAN (D-10-00002) to allow for modifications to a previously approved floor plan, elevations, the site plan, and conceptual landscape plan for the Pepper Tree subdivision located south west of Mission Avenue and Valley Heights Drive. – *This item has been continued to the August 23, 2010 public hearing.*

Building Height Standards - Consideration of ZONE AMENDMENT (ZA09-00001) and LOCAL COASTAL PROGRAM AMENDMENT (LCPA10-00002) to consider amendments to the 1986 and 1992 Zoning Ordinances to modify building height standards. – *The Commissioners voted 6-1 (Scrivener – Abstain) to continue this item to the August 23, 2010 public hearing.*
