Oceanside Historic Preservation Advisory Committee

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Oceanside Historic Preservation Advisory Commission reviewed and took action on at their meeting on Tuesday, August 3, 2010.

<u>Mission Douglas Plaza Comp Rev</u> – Consideration of Comprehensive Sign Program (CSP10-00001) and Historic Permit (H10-00001) to allow revisions to the existing sign program for the Mission and Douglas Plaza to enable an upgrade to the existing north west multi-tenant pole sign located at 3905 Mission Avenue. *The Commission voted in favor for the recommendation of approval to the City Planner by a 5-0 vote (Buccola – Absent).*

Grant for Oceanside S.U.N. 2010 Awarded

The Neighborhood Services Department was successful in obtaining a grant in the amount of \$5,000 from Home Depot to support the SUN 2010 project on October 23, 2010. The grant will be used to purchase painting equipment, rollers, gloves, tape, and ladders. Staff is working on securing other grants and sponsorships to make the ninth annual SUN project a success!

El Corazon Senior Center Enhancement

The Senior Center Drive main entrance to El Corazon Senior Center is being enhanced through entrance and perimeter landscaping as part of the Rancho Del Oro Road improvements. This entry enhancement comes one year after the opening of the senior center because the slopes were being assessed prior to planting. The new landscaping will assist residents with identification of the gateway to the senior center.

South O Merchants discuss I-5 Widening

The South O Merchants Association is having a meeting on August 11, 2010 at 6:00 pm at the Beach Break restaurant in South Oceanside regarding the proposed widening by Caltrans of the I-5 freeway and the impact on access into South Oceanside. The purpose of the meeting is to gain some understanding of the proposal before the Caltrans meeting planned for September 9th at Oceanside High School. City staff has been asked to attend the meeting and supply whatever information they currently have about the proposal and its impacts to access to South Oceanside.
