Planning Department

Listed below are the public hearing items that the Planning Commission will review at their meeting on Monday, September 13, 2010:

COURTYARD BY MARRIOTT – Consideration of a DEVELOPMENT PLAN (D10-00004) and CONDITIONAL USE PERMITS (CUP10-00013, CUP10-00014 & CUP10-00015) to allow for the development of a four-story, 78,489-sqaure-foot business hotel containing 140 guest rooms, an outdoor swimming pool with spa, a bistro, lobby area, board room, a 2,000-square-foot meeting space, an associated parking lot and landscape improvements located east of Rancho del Oro Drive and on Seagate Way. *Staff is recommending approval.*

BUGGY BATH – Consideration of a CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT (CUP10-00006) to allow the selling of small grocery, snack items, beer and wine in addition to the permitted auto-related car wash items that were approved with the previously approved Conditional Use Permit (C-36-89) located at 2946 Oceanside Boulevard. *Staff is recommending approval.*

BUILDING HEIGHT STANDARDS – Consideration of ZONE AMENDMENT (ZA09-00001) and LOCAL COASTAL PROGRAM AMENDMENT (LCPA10-00002) to consider amendments to the 1986 and 1992 Zoning Ordinances to modify building height standards. *Staff is recommending approval.*

DILLON RESIDENCE – Consideration of a REGULAR COASTAL PERMIT (RC10-00007) for the construction of a 248-square-foot deck expansion attached to an existing deck at the western building elevation located at 1011 South Pacific Street. *This item has been continued to the September 27, 2010 public hearing.*

Neighborhood Services Department

Cal State University "Senior Experience" to benefit Parks and Rec – The Neighborhood Services Department has been selected to participate in the "Senior Experience" program at Cal State University San Marcos. The program matches organizations, such as the City of Oceanside, with a team of University students in their senior year who, as a graduation requirement, must complete a semester-long "internship" relating to their area of study. The "Senior Experience" team will work with Parks and Recreation in the development of a community assessment tool to measure efficiencies in service delivery and customer satisfaction of currently offered recreation

programs. The outcome will be statistically valid information that will be used to enhance current recreation user satisfaction and to increase the overall customer base.
